Need help? If you're having trouble deciding which school or program is the right fit, schedule a free appointment with an expert education coach. To get started, log into the EdAssist by Bright Horizons portal and select the Education Coaching Tab or call EdAssist at 877-276-7115 between 5 a.m. and 5 p.m. PT, Monday – Friday.

Once you have selected your school and worked directly through their process to enroll, you will need to submit an application for Tuition Assistance.

Application Instructions

1. First, log into the **EdAssist** portal. Keep in mind: you must apply for tuition assistance before your course starts or no later than 45 days following the first day of class.
2. First-time User - Click "Sign Up" and follow prompts to register.
Already Registered for Bright Horizons Back-Up Care? Use your existing credentials to log in to the EdAssist by Bright Horizons portal.
3. Start your application by following the steps below. Please note: Your tuition benefit does not cover non-degree certification programs nor Continuing Education Units (CEUs).

Add Contact Information

- Make sure your contact information is accurate.

Add Program Information

- Select your program.
- Enter your degree and field of study.
- Enter and/or review educational provider information.

Add Course Information

- Enter your course dates.

- Enter your course details including name and tuition cost.
- Enter the fees covered by the policy.
 - If you need to request a book reimbursement, you can return to your application to enter book expenses after your course ends.
 - Unsure of your final expenses? Reach out to your University Advisor to confirm the exact cost.

Sign Agreements

- Enter any financial aid you will receive.
- Read and acknowledge the participation agreements.

Review & Submit Your Application

- Confirm that all information is complete and accurate and submit your application.
- Once the EdAssist system verifies that you meet the basic program eligibility guidelines, your application will be forwarded to your manager for review.
- Once approved by your manager, a Letter of Credit (LOC) will be emailed to you. Print, sign, and submit the LOC to your school.

Submit Your Grades

Return to the [EdAssist](#) portal no later than 90 days after your course end date and upload your grade documents. If T-Mobile has paid for your course, but you do not receive a grade of C- or better (or a “Pass”), you’ll be suspended from submitting Tuition Assistance applications for 12 months following the course end date. You do have the option to repay T-Mobile the full cost of the course to lift the suspension.

Repayment is managed by T-Mobile. Please go to <https://magentapulse.t-mobile.com/us/en/company-culture/employee-reources/myhr/contact-myhr> to connect with the myHR team regarding setting up deductions for your repayment and provide the Tuition Assistance application number. You may also call myHR directly at (866) 578-6423, M-F 5 a.m. – 5 p.m. Pacific.

After enrolling at your school of choice, create an application in the portal by the 45th day of the course.

Provide the Letter of Credit (LOC) to your school.

4

Your school will invoice EdAssist, and they will remit payment for eligible expenses.

5

Upload your final grade within 90 days following your course end date.
